• Find out what help children need as soon as we can.

• Support children as they get older.

This means more help at important times for example when children move to adult services.



- Check the support at all Birmingham schools and education settings.
- Work with local teams in community settings.



• Make sure services, families and children communicate well.



 Have skilled staff that don't change often and have lots of training.



• Use information to help more children.

We will find out who needs help, decide where we work and how to help them.

We will know when we have made a difference when...

• Children and their families tell us that our services are good.



- Children are happy with the support they get.
- Children can tell us about what they want to do and where they want to do it.
- We have better places with better equipment to help children.
