

Overview: This training will provide participants with an understanding of Emotionally Based School Non-Attendance (EBSNA) for both primary and secondary settings, highlighting the importance of early intervention and creating a reflective space to explore who is at risk, what the early warning signs are and what can be done to support YP and their families when barriers to attendance arise. The training will provide staff with tools and ideas that they can take back to their settings to support YP at risk of non-attendance.

Who is it for?

The training is suitable for any staff members working to support attendance in mainstream settings, or for any staff wanting to gain a better understanding of why EBSNA can occur.

Outcomes:

- Staff will have an understanding of what EBSNA is and who is most at risk.
- Staff will understand the importance of protective factors in supporting attendance and well-being.
- Staff will be confident to use tools that support them to understand the factors that may be contributing to a YP's attendance and to put in place appropriate support.
