

Strengthening Information Sharing for Year 6-7 Transition

What is this showcase about?

Swanshurst School worked with feeder primary schools to strengthen the transfer of information about pupils with SEND during the move from Year 6 to Year 7. The project focused on improving communication with families and ensuring that strategies, provision and support were understood by staff before pupils arrived in secondary school. Through earlier meetings with primary schools, clearer information-sharing and engagement with families, the school aimed to reduce anxiety and help pupils feel confident and prepared for the move to secondary education.

Expect to see...

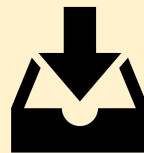
- Reflections on how earlier information sharing between primary and secondary schools can strengthen transition planning

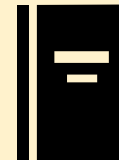
