What is this showcase about?

The Oratory RC Primary School developed a structured approach to supporting pupils and families during the transition from Year 6 to Year 7. The project focused on reducing anxiety for pupils, particularly those with SEND, and ensuring families felt informed and supported during the secondary transfer process. Through pupil transition sessions, parent information events and closer working with receiving secondary schools, the school created opportunities for pupils and families to understand what secondary school will be like and feel prepared for the next stage of education.

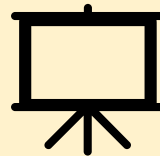
- Reflections on how structured transition activities can help pupils understand and prepare for the move to secondary school
