<b>In Setting Transition</b>
<p>These resources and strategies are designed to help children and young people of all ages, and their families when they move to a new setting—whether it's a planned phase transfer or a move during the school year.</p> <p>The goal is to support everyone involved so that the child or young person can settle in smoothly and successfully.</p>
<p><b>For Parent/ Carers:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Welcome to the new year group - opportunities to meet the new teacher e.g. open evening, drop in, meeting</li> <li>• Communication with parent/ carers re: new staff/ equipment and changes e.g., via newsletter, online portals, reports. Use of translators if required.</li> <li>• Parent/ carers meetings/ evenings in early Autumn term about settling in</li> <li>• Transition booklet/ photo book shared with all parent/ carers</li> <li>• Parent / carers workshops e.g., on curriculum information (assessments or exams that take place in year group, revision, GCSE options, careers), IT safety, expectations SEND coffee morning on how to support CYP with successful transition</li> <li>• One Page Profiles written with parent/ carers and CYP shared with new staff before transition events</li> <li>• Individual person-centred transition meetings with parents and key school staff (e.g. Senco, class teacher, Learning Mentor, Head of Year)</li> <li>• Information sessions or workshops for transition into new key stage e.g. Ready, Steady, Reception!, curriculum changes, preparation for exams, KS4 programmes of study</li> </ul>
